Snow Emergency Declaration

South Coatesville Borough — Mayor Henry Carey has declared a Snow Emergency for the Borough of South Coatesville, effective **Saturday, January 24, 2026, at 7:00 p.m.**, in anticipation of a winter storm expected to impact the region from Saturday evening through Monday.

The anticipated storm poses a threat to the health, safety, and welfare of a substantial number of Borough residents and may create conditions that exceed the Borough's normal response capabilities. As a result, emergency management measures are necessary to reduce the severity of the storm's impact and to protect residents and public property. All vehicles must be moved from designated snow emergency routes during this time. Vehicles in violation are subject to ticketing and towing at the owner's expense.

Mayor Carey has authorized the South Coatesville Borough Manager to coordinate response efforts with public works, fire, emergency medical services, and state police, and to take all appropriate actions necessary to alleviate the effects of the storm. This authorization includes actions required to restore essential public services and to implement additional emergency response measures as deemed necessary.

The Borough Manager is further authorized to take actions required for storm recovery, including the employment of temporary workers; the rental of equipment; the purchase of supplies and materials; and the execution of contracts or agreements for public work necessary to address the emergency. These actions may be taken without regard to time-consuming procedures and formalities normally prescribed by law, except for mandatory constitutional requirements.

Residents are urged to exercise caution during the storm and to monitor the Borough website for updates and additional information. The Snow Emergency declaration remains in effect until lifted.
